




Tech Tips – Hiding a Column in Output

- You can now hide columns in IBM SPSS Statistics version 29.0.1.
- Users can right-click output and chose Modify Output to transpose, hide, sort, and highlight.

- Once you have your output simply right click on the table.
- Select **Modify Output** and **Hide Column**.





Tech Tips – Hiding a Column in Output

- In the example below, we have hidden Percent and Cumulative percent.
