


# Reclassify Fields

# Reclassify

- Did you know there is a quick way to reclassify fields in IBM SPSS Modeler?
- The Reclassify node allows users to recode variables.
- For example, you have categories of risk and want to reclassify it into 'Good' and 'Bad' risk categories to use in further analyses.
